

USEFUL INFORMATION

PITCHES

The site has pitches suitable for caravans, tents and motorhomes. Many pitches have electric hook ups. We also offer select pitches in the pinewood area close to the sandy beaches of Loch Morlich - your own large pitch with electric hook up and your own picnic table.

OPENING DATES

The site is open from **1st January 2003** until **3rd November 2003**, then re opens on **18th December 2003**. Ideal for your summer holiday, a low season short break, or a winter skiing or climbing holiday.

RECEPTION

Reception is normally open between **8am and 6pm**, seven days a week. In low season these hours may be reduced. When Reception is closed there is an emergency contact number for the Site Manager clearly displayed at Reception.

You will also see the site staff around the site, organising the cleaning and day-to-day running of the site.

Local tourist information is available at the noticeboard outside Reception. For more information on the area, please do not hesitate to ask the Site Manager.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

Pitches are available from noon on your day of arrival. If you wish to extend your stay, please contact Reception before **10am on your expected departure date**.

LATE ARRIVALS

You may pitch up to **10pm**. If you arrive when Reception is closed, please find a vacant pitch and book in at Reception by **10am** the following day. The access gate to the site is open between **7.30am** and **10pm**.

SPEED LIMIT

The speed limit on-site is **10 mph**. As there are often young children playing, we ask you to take special care when driving on site. For the safety of our customers, a one-way system operates on the site. Please observe the direction signs.

NOISE

Please keep noise at a level which will not disturb other site users, especially between **10pm** and **8am**.

DOGS

We welcome up to three well behaved dogs, provided they are kept on a lead at all times and are exercised away from the site. If you have a dog, please remove all traces of its presence before you leave.

CLEANLINESS

We make every effort to keep the site facilities clean and tidy. If you have any comments on the standards of cleanliness please contact Reception. We ask for your assistance in keeping the site clean by using the refuse bins and chemical disposal points, and by leaving all facilities clean after use.

BARBECUES

Because of the **danger of fires in the forest, open fires are not allowed on-site or on the beach area**. Barbecues may be lit provided they are raised off the ground and are in a suitable container. Please ensure that smoke and fumes do not annoy other site users. In times of very dry weather, when the fire risk is high, the use of barbecues may be restricted. We also provide a central barbecue area on site, which you are welcome to use at any time.

WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

Fire extinguishers are placed in prominent positions around the site. In case of fire dial **999**, then notify the Site Manager immediately. In a medical emergency, you will find the number for the duty doctor/hospital on the site noticeboard opposite Reception and by the public phone.
